## **Inclement Weather Policy**

School districts announce school closures in the early morning prior to students leaving their homes to get to school. Unfortunately they also cancel all evening activities regardless of changes in weather and/or road conditions that occur throughout the day. Because of that, we will not mirror the cancellation decision made by the Bellevue School District to decide if we will close or not on a particular day.

Sudden Impact will announce if the I-90 Volleyball Center will be closed <u>no earlier than three (3) hours prior to a scheduled activity</u>. The notice of facility closure will be posted to the club's website unless there is a power outage and we are unable to do that. Should that happen, teams will be notified by their head coach or his/her designee.

Club members should assume that the facility will be open unless it is posted to the website (or they are notified) that the facility will be closed that day.

Sudden Impact recognizes that members of our club come from far and varying distances to get to the I-90 Volleyball Center, therefore attendance at scheduled activities during inclement weather (regardless of what the club decides to do) should be made on a case by case basis by each family. The last thing we want is for anyone to get injured trying to get to or from practice.

Should you decide not to attend a scheduled activity due to inclement weather, you need to notify your head coach that you will not be there.
